- 44. To fight the stigma of social evils, untouchability, Female foeticide, Female Infanticide, Gender discrimination, Gender violence, Dowry, Girl child marriages, alcohol and substance abuse, trafficking in girls and women for physical and sexual abuse.
- 45. To sensitize youth through Leadership, sensitisation, Sports, Vocational training, literacy development, continuing education and Career counseling.


46. To convene, hold and summon any meetings, seminars and conventions independently or jointly with Common Interest Intuitions having the same spirit, interest, goals and motives.

- 50. To collaborate with Agencies and Institutions who would be willing to provide academic and non-academic assistance to the students and to accredit such learning centres or study centres.
- 51. To conduct and promote educational programmes through various media networks like Radio and T.V., newspapers etc.
- 52. To organize and conduct Seminars & Workshops on Digital Marketing, Financial Literacy, Investment awareness etc for the benefit of the people of the Society.

53. To outsource and utilise the services of Facility Management Companies to help run smoothly the activities of the Institutions run by the Trust.

- 55. To hire and utilise the services of marketing companies / other agencies to help develop the institutions and bodies run by the Trust so as to achieve the objectives of the Trust.

INCIDENTAL OBJECTIVES:

With a view to promoting the foregoing objectives the TRUST shall have the following ancillary and incidental objectives:

- to acquire by way of lease, sub-lease, License, gift, purchase, exchange, hire or in any other manner, any movable or immovable properties and any rights or privileges necessary or convenient for the purposes of the Trust and to construct, erect, alter, improve and maintain any building and to demolish or repair buildings and to manage, develop, sell, let, dispose off, mortgage, or otherwise deal with all or any part of the assets and rights of the Trust with a view to achieving the objectives of the Trust;
- 2. to accept grants of money, equipment, land, buildings, donations, gifts, subscriptions and other assistance from the Central Government or a State Government, international multilateral or bilateral funding agencies or from any other source and to conform to the conditions on which such grants, payments and assistance may be received, provided that no benefaction shall be accepted by the Trust, which in its opinion involves conditions or obligations contrary to the objectives of the Trust;

3. To undertake and accept the management of any endowment or trust or donations in furtherance of the objectives of the Trust.



- 6. To negotiate with and enter into agreement and arrangement with any Government Authorities whether Centre, State, International, Bilateral, Multilateral, Corporate, District, Municipal, Local Universities, Boards or other Public or Private bodies as may deem conducive to the promotion and accomplishment of the trust or any of them and to apply for, obtain, collect, receive or recover from any such Government or Authorities or Bodies such Grants, allowances, concessions and privileges as may be from time to time.
- No member of the trust shall have any personal claim on any moveable or immoveable property / properties of the Trust or make any profit, whatsoever by virtue of his Membership in this Trust.
- To collect contributions to the General Fund of the Trust in the form of Donations, Membership Fee, Annual Subscriptions, Affiliation Fee and Service Charges etc., which may be determined by the Governing Board from time to time.
- To apply the income and properties of the Trust for public or charitable purpose only in accordance with the provisions u/sec. 11, 12 and 13 of the Income Tax Act, 1961 and relevant provisions applicable from time to time.

5. TRUSTEES TO RENDER TRUE ACCOUNTS: -

The trustees shall cause true and accurate accounts to be kept of all moneys received and spent and all materials in respect thereof in the course of management of trust fund or in relation to carrying out the objects and purposes of the trust as well as assets, credits and efforts of the trust.

6. POWERS OF THE TRUSTEES: -

The Board of trustees shall have the control and management of the trust. The trustees named above shall be the first board of trustees who may co-opt or select the other trustees.

For the furtherance of the objects, i.e., for service to the public in general and to the poor and weaker sections of the Society as mentioned in Clause 4. The trustees will have the following powers which will be exercised by them:

- χ. To convert and deal with investments comprised in the trust fund and/or to carry the investment for the time being in the modes prescribed u/s.11 (5) of the I.T. Act, 1961 And each other provisions and amendments thereof from to time.
- δ. To invest and keep invested the trust fund either in the purchase or mortgage of immovable property including a flat or in units, shares, stocks, or debentures permitted by the Indian Trust Act, 1882 or any other statute, or deposit with banks, firms and to alter, vary or transpose such investments from time to time



The funds and the income of the trust shall be solely utilized for the achievement of its objectives and no portion of it shall be utilized for payments of the trustees by way of profit, interest, dividends, etc.

9. NUMBER OF TRUSTEES: -

11. NOTICE PERIOD: -

Every trustee will be at liberty to resign on giving one month's notice of his/her intention to do so.

12. MEETING & PROCEEDINGS OF THE TRUST:

- 1) The trustees shall ordinarily meet once in 12 months or as often as may be necessary for the satisfactory conduct of the assets of the trust.
- 2) A minutes books shall be kept by the Secretary of entry to the office of every new trustee and of all proceedings of the meeting of the board of trustees shall be entered in the minute book and shall be signed by the Secretary of the trust.

13. QUORUM: -

The trustees may, from time to time, frame rules for the conduct and regulation of the meetings of the trustees.

In the absence of such regulations;

The board of trustees will decide all matters.

Any resolution passed without any meeting of the trustees but by circulation thereof and evidenced in writing under the hands of two-thirds of the trustees shall be as valid and effectual as a resolution duly passed at a meeting of the trustees. The Chairman of the Trust shall have a casting vote in the event of equality of vote in addition to his own.

14. AMALGAMATION:

15. INVESTMENT: -

16. ACCOUNTS: -

There shall be maintenance of accounts of the Trust. A Chartered Accountant shall duly audit the accounts. Every year the Accounts shall be closed on 31st March.

17. AMENDMENT: -

No amendment to the Memorandum of Trust, Rules and regulations of the Trust shall be made which may prove to be repugnant to the provisions of Sec.2 (15), 11, 12, 13 and 80G of the Income Tax Act, 1961 as amended from time to time. Further no amendment shall be carried out without the prior approval of the commissioner of Income Tax, Karnataka Circle.

18. DISSOLUTION: -

In the event of dissolution or winding up of the Trust, the assets remaining as on the date or dissolution shall under no circumstances be distributed among the members of the Managing committee/Governing body but the same shall be transferred to another charitable Trust/Trust whose objects are similar to those of this Trust and which enjoys recognition u/s.80G of the I.T.Act, 1961 as amended from time to time.

23. In case of changes in the name, address and objects and achievement of the Trust is to be honestly informed and is to be submitted to the Deputy Secretary F.C.R.A. Office of the home department Government of India, New Delhi. In case of changes under these circumstances the new Registration Number is to be allotted as per law.

- 24. In case of publication published by the Trust under F.C.R.A. Act, 1967, if Trust acts as editor, publisher, reporter, columnist, cartoonist they have to submit a report to the office concerned.
- 25. Before receiving donation from the Foreign country or from any Indian Trust, the Trust must take permission as per F.C.R.A. Rules and its direction, as stated above.

26. POWERS OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE: -

CHAIRMAN: -

He/she shall be over all in charge of the Trust and the General body meetings. All the policies and programmes shall be formulated and implemented only through him/her in consultation with executive committee.

He/she shall be the chief executive head of the trust.

In his/her absence he/she shall depute the Trustees with suitable advice to deliberate on all major or minor matters concerning the Trust. He/she shall countersign the annual reports, audited statement of accounts & such other documents along with the Trustees and auditors.

He/she shall advice on investment of surplus funds in Govt. Securities, Autonomous Govt. Bodies, Private financial Companies, etc., and he/she shall advice on borrowing/lending of finance for the trust either on interest or without interest and authorizes the Secretary on all financial matters in the interest of the trust.

Under the guidance & advice of Trustees he/she shall be authorized to appoint. dismiss, reinstate any of the employee. And can appoint temporary substitute staff and fix their remuneration. He/she shall grant leave of absence, and generally ensure smooth function of the trust.

SECRETARY: -

He/she shall call for all meetings of the General body as and when deemed necessary and the General body meetings and the Special General body meetings as per the rules with the previous approval of the President and maintain the minute's book and record of all the proceedings of the meetings.

TREASURER: -

He/she shall be the custodian of all the funds and investments of the Trust and all the accounts. He/she shall maintain all accounts and records and shall receive cash on behalf of the Trust. He/she shall prepare a Balance sheet of the Income and Expenditure each year for the presentation to the General body with the approval of President and Secretary.
